SRNS Surpasses 10 Million Safe Work Hours and Counting

AIKEN, S.C. (April 7, 2015) – Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, LLC (SRNS) employees take safety seriously, and their commitment shows in their safety performance. They achieved a significant safety milestone the week of March 15, 2015, by working over 10 million hours without a lost work day case.

This is the second longest streak of safe work hours achieved by the company since SRNS took over the contract in 2008, surpassed only by a 24.8 million man-hour milestone achieved in 2013.

“It takes a lot of attention to detail and focus on safe behaviors for our employees to perform hazardous work safely and achieve such a significant accomplishment. Most impressively, when the unlikely event of an injury does occur, our employees come back stronger than ever and look for opportunities to prevent recurrence,” said Alice Doswell, SRNS Senior Vice President for Environmental Services, Safety and Health. “It is that resilience and commitment to safe performance that enables SRNS to have a world class safety culture.”

To breakdown how impressive a safe-work record like this is, it would take one human 5,000 years to work 10 million safe work hours.

A significant contributor to this safety achievement is attributed to SRNS’ Project Management and Construction Services (PMCS) division, who also recently surpassed an organizational

safety milestone of 3 million safe hours worked without a lost work day due to injury. This organization supports all site facilities and conducts some of the most hazardous work at the Savannah River Site (SRS).

“In an industry known for physical hazards and worker injury, it is a noteworthy accomplishment that the SRNS PMCS organization has surpassed 3 million safe work hours without a lost work day injury. The safety culture within PMCS is a common thread among the employees and sets a standard for personal accountability for safety,” said Doswell.
