Jon R. Lunn is Senior Vice President of Savannah River Plutonium Processing Facility (SRPPF) Project Execution for Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, LLC (SRNS) at the Savannah River Site (SRS) in Aiken, South Carolina. His responsibility in this role is the safe execution and delivery of the Engineering, Procurement, and Construction (EPC) of the SRPPF Project, a multi-billion-dollar Capital Line-Item project.

Prior to his current role, Lunn led the Project Management Office (PMO) for the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Capital Projects (NCP) organization, which included oversight of SRPPF project as well as the Tritium Finishing Facility (TFF) project and the Surplus Plutonium Disposition (SPD) project. In this role, he led the development of all EPC-related processes, procedures and training as well as provided oversight of functional group performance, risk analysis and self-assessments. Prior to that assignment, Lunn was project director for the Saltstone Disposal Units (SDU) at SRS. He led the project from conceptual design through turnover-to-operations.

Lunn has 43 years of experience in project management, engineering, quality assurance, procurement, construction, start-up, subcontract formation and management, project controls, operational readiness, and business and program execution. He began his career as an engineer in the commercial nuclear industry with both domestic and international assignments and transferred to SRS in 1989 where he has held assignments of increasing responsibility in project and program management for over three decades.
