Event opportunities:

- **Engage with colleges, military and professional societies:** Meet representatives from colleges, universities, and technical schools across the U.S., along with local professional societies and four military branches.
- **Explore financial aid options:** Get detailed information on scholarships and financial aid requirements for South Carolina and Georgia and attend financial literacy seminars.
- **Visit the Counseling Center:** High school advisors and admissions professionals will be available to guide students through the college application process.
- **Discover career opportunities:** Participate in career interest "card sorting" to help validate and explore career choices.
- **Win scholarships:** High school seniors can register for a chance to win one of fifteen \$1,000 scholarships, provided they graduate with a GPA of 2.5 or above.



Scholarships totaling \$15,000 will be awarded at this year's CSRA College Night.
