Savannah River Nuclear Solutions Promotes STEM Education with \$25,000 Donation to Sponsor Dreams Imagination & Gift Development Programs

AIKEN, S.C., November 2, 2021 – Savannah River Nuclear Solutions (SRNS) continues to annually demonstrate their support of the Dreams, Imagination & Gift Development Program (DIG), a local organization providing science, technology, education and math (STEM) opportunities to promote rural growth and development through education, community service, mentorship and recreation.

This year's \$25,000 sponsorship will aide in administering DIG's Annual Summer STEAM (STEM, plus art) Enrichment Camp, Scholar Enrichment Academy (after-school program) and Drive-In STEM Theatre. With SRNS's continued support, DIG has strengthened its after-school programs and is now offering both a hybrid model of virtual and in-person after-school enrichment. In addition to math, English language arts and STEAM, DIG has also expanded its curriculum to include app development and financial literacy.

Since 2013, DIG has been committed to providing educational and inspirational opportunities for area youth to excel. During this time, SRNS has committed more than \$90,000 to help this grassroots organization make dreams a reality.


"We appreciate the DIG organization and the tremendous impact it has had on communities throughout the region," said SRNS President and CEO Stuart MacVean."
